CITY OFFICE PARTIALLY OPENS ON SATURDAYS MARCH 30 & APRIL 13 FOR REPORTS RELATED TO CHANGE OF RESIDENCE

Because most Japanese schools and companies start their new year on April 1st, the City Office receives many notifications and applications around this time. For your convenience, the City Office will provide a limited range of services on <u>March 30 (Saturday) between 8:30 a.m. and 5:15 p.m. and April 13 (Saturday) between 8:30 a.m. and noon.</u>

Do not take a day off for your paperwork, but use these opportunities. Note that the official documents to be submitted to the Immigration Office expire three months from the date of issuance.

SERVICES AVAILABLE: ►Shimin-ka (Section for Citizens): notification of change of address (move-in and move-out), seal (inkan) registration, issurance of resident certificate (juminhyo) and permanent family register (koeki), receipt of a new passport. ►Kokuho Iryo-ka (Section for Health Insurance & Medical Service): application for membership and withdrawal from the National Health Insurance. ►Kodomo Shien-ka (Section for Child Support)*: application for Child Allowance and Child Medical Subsidy Program ►Gakko Kyoiku-ka (Section for School Education)*: procedures for changing schools ►Shuzei-ka (Section for Tax Collection)*: payment of city taxes

*The Kodomo Shieni-ka and the Shuzei-ka located on the 2nd floor and the Gakko Kyoiku-ka on the 4th floor will use the windows of other sections on the first floor on these days. Ask for the details at a window. **Regular Shimin-Ka Opening on Saturday on March 9 and 23** from 8:30 a.m. till noon.

FILE YOUR FINAL TAX RETURN BY THE 15TH OF THIS MONTH

Tax returns for the year 2018 should be filed by March 15 (Fri). You can do this filing procedure at the City Office from Monday to Friday until March 15. Bring your Gensen Choshu-Hyo, and other supporting documents such as documents relating to dependents, a certificate of health insurance/life insurance premium payment, and so on. If you have gone through the year-end adjustment (nenmatsu chosei) procedures by your company, you do not have to worry about the final tax return, except when you have any deductible expenses not reported to the company such as a large amount of medical expenses and housing loan.

Documents Necessary for Exemption for Dependents Living Abroad

If you apply for an exemption for dependents with regard to your relatives living abroad, you are required to attach "Documents concerning relatives" and "Documents concerning remittances" and their Japanese translations to the tax return forms. The form is a document issued by a foreign government to prove that you have a family relationship with the person to whom you send money for his/her living or education expenses.

The latter is a document issued by a financial institution to prove payment you made to a family member living abroad. It must include the name of the remitter, the name of the receiver, and the amount and date of remittance. If you apply for exemption for more than one family member, you need to submit a separate document for each of them. Note that applications for exemption for dependents living abroad cannot be handled by the City Office, and so you need to go to Tokorozawa Taxation Office.

HOLIDAY MEDICAL SERVICES

If you or a family member becomes sick or injured on these days, visit a hospital on the list. Healthcare covered by health insurance is provided from 9:00 a.m. to noon and 1:00 to 5:00 p.m. Please make a call before visiting. These services are basically for patients who do not need to be hospitalized.

RENEWAL OF 'PAPA & MAMA SUPPORT' CARD

Courtesy cards, called Papa & Mama Support Card, are issued by Saitama Prefecture for households with children

up to high school age and those with a mother-to-be. With this card you can receive store-specific preferential services at 345 participating stores in Iruma. The current cards will expire at the end of this month, and a new card will be distributed at at the Kodomo Shien-ka (Section for Child Support) in the City Office, City Branch Offices or Kenko Fukushi (Health & Welfare) Center. REPORT DISPOSAL OF LIGHT CARS AND MOTORCYCLES

Disposal or transfer of ownership of a light car (small cars less than 660cc) or motorcycle must be reported to the designated offices by the end of March every year, otherwise the registered owner as of April 1 will receive a bill for tax for the next fiscal year. Iruma City Office deals with 50cc motorcycles only. For other motorcycles, report to Tokorozawa Jidosha Kensa Toroku Jimusho **2** 050-5540-2029, and for light cars to Keijidosha Kensa Kyokai Tokorozawa Shisho **2** 050-3816-3111. **Inquiries**: Shimin-zei-ka (Section for City Tax).

DOG REGISTRATION & VACCINATION

In Japan, the law requires that all dogs 91 days and older are registered and get an annual receive rabies shot between April and June. The City will offer vaccinations between April 16 and May 18 at a number of different locations throughout the City, and mail a notice to owners of registered dogs. Applications for new registration (valid for the life of the dog) will be accepted at these sites and costs 3,000 yen. Shots are 3,300 yen. You can also get your dog receive a shot (the price for shot may vary) and receive a certificate of vaccination at designated animal hospitals in the city. **Inquiries**: Kankyo-ka (Section for the Environment)
