IT'S ABOUT TIME TO GET MEDICAL CHECKUP FREE HEALTH EXAMINATION FOR NATIONAL HEALTH INSURANCE MEMBERS

In late May, the Iruma City Office sent a free medical check-up voucher (受診券 *jushin ken*) to all National Health Insurance members ages over 40 and less than 75. The voucher is for a Specific Medical Checkup (特定键診 Tokuei Kenshin) where you can use it in a medical clinic or hospitals in the City between June and December this year. The check-up will focus mainly on the prevention of lifestyle-related diseases and will include blood tests, urine test and an electrocardiogram. For those who are covered by a company's health insurance, a similar opportunity for health checkup will be given by the company. People who are 75 years of age and over should have received a similar voucher for a Medical Checkup for Later-Stage Elderly People (後期高齢者健診 Koki Koreisha Kenshin). This is valid from June to February 2020. To take these checkups, make an appointment at a hospital/clinic beforehand, and bring a completed interview sheet (the voucher) and your health insurance card with you. **Inquires**: the Kenko Kanri-ka (Section for Health Management) **20**4-2966-5511

ALSO FREE CANCER EXAMINATION OF YOUR CHOICE

The City also office provides free cancer examinations for citizens who have no chance to take these exams at workplace, regardless of their type of health insurnace. Examinations available in this program include lung cancer, colon cancer, stomach caner, breast cancer, cervical cancer and prostate cancer, as well as hepatitis and tuberculosis. Guidance and lectures on Japanese high school entrance examination system for students and parents whose mother language are not Japanese will be held with cooperation with Saitama Prefecture and private volunteer groups in this area. It will take place on July 20 (Sat) at 1:30 p.m. (the reception starts at 1:00 p.m.) at the Kodomo-to Fukushi-no Miraikan (address:1861-1 Izumi-cho Tokorozawa City), a 5-minute walk from the west exit of Shin-Tokorozawa Station on Seibu Shinjuku Line. Lectures on the high school entrance system will be given in Japanese, but interpretation will be available. You can

also hear about the experiences of older non-native students and will have the chance to personally speak with teachers from high schools. If you have any question about your qualification, this is the best chance to get answer. Admission is free, however prior registration is required. NEW TENANT INVITED FOR MUNICIPAL HOUSING UNITS



New tenant for vacancies of municipal apartments are invited this month. Application forms are available until June 21 (Fri) at the Toshi Keikaku-ka (Section for City Planning), City Branch Offices (Higashi-Kaneko, Kaneko,

Miyadera, Fujisawa and Seibu) and Satellite Offices (Kurosu and Higashi-Fujisawa). Apply by June 21 by mail (must be postmarked by the date). The application process is handled by the Prefectural Housing Cooperation (jutaku Kyokyu Kosha). Just like prefectural apartments, candidates are selected by lottery and then their eligibility is reviewed with various documents such as income certificates. There are income limits applicable.

The City provides a child allowance (児童手当 *Jido Teate*) to households bringing up children up to the end of junior high school. You must renew your registration every year. Early this month, the City Office will mail forms to those who are already receiving child allowance (現況屆 *Genkyo-todoke*). DENTAL ORAL HEALTHCARE FAIR

FREE HIV TEST AT SAYAMA HOKENJO

The Sayama Hokenjo (Public Health Department, near Sayama Police Station) provides a free HIV testing on the third (or second) Monday every month; namely on June 17, July 8 and August 19. Come between 1:30 and 2:30 p.m. then you will know the result one hour after blood sampling. You can take a test anonymously but need to make an appointment by phone. To improve the accuracy of the results, it is advised that you take the test at least three months after suspected exposure. CITY FACILITY MANAGEMENT PLAN FINALIZED

The City has been discussing how we could manage city facilities with the lowest costs while addressing citizen's changing needs. After listening to opinions and suggestions from public comments and meetings with the people since 2017, the City finalized the City Facility Management Plan last month. This three-decade plan (2019 to 2048) outlines when and how each facility should be remodeled, reconstructed or closed, based on a feasible financial planning in a long term. Iruma COM+COM will introduce and update this plan constantly to you, the taxpayers.

Basic Policy for Community Facilities:

Komin-kan: They will transform to a Chiku (Community) Center in 2022, which has six functions; namely, a city branch office, a citizen's activity place, a welfare consultation desk, a disaster preparation base, a support base for autonomous work, and a elderly welfare base. The current 13 kominkan will be merged into 9 community centers.

Elementary and Junior High Schools: To ensure proper size and allocation of schools, the current 16 elementary and 11 junior high schools will be nine of each.

After School Nursery Rooms: In accordance with the consolidation of schools, the nursery rooms will be integrated into each school.

Public Nursery Schools: They will be consolidated, based on the number of children in needs and the development of private schools. **Branch Libraries and Area Gymnasiums**: Their current facilities will be maintained.

Basic Policy for Facilities which Covers the Whole City

City Office, Shimin Kaikan Hall, City Museum, Health & Welfare Center, etc.: They will be remodeled, reconstructed, closed, or privatized as needed.
