# JULY 20 (Sat) at 1:30 p.m. at Tokorozawa Kodomo-to Fukushi-no Miraikan

With cooperation with Saitama Prefecture and private volunteer groups in this area, guidance and lectures on Japanese high school entrance examination system for students and parents whose mother language are not Japanese will be held once a year. This year's event will take place on July 20 (Sat) at 1:30 p.m. (the reception starts at 1:00 p.m.) at the Kodomo-to Fukushi-no Miraikan (address:1861-1 Izumi-cho Tokorozawa City), a 5-minute walk from the west exit of

Shin-Tokorozawa Station on Seibu Shinjuku Line. Lectures on the high school entrance system will be given in Japanese, but interpretation will be available. You can also hear about the experiences of older non-native students and will have the chance to personally speak with teachers from high schools. # NEW EVACUATION ADVISORY BASED ON ALERT LEVELS

In accordance with the amendment to the Guidelines on Evacuation Advisories in March, the City of Iruma now provides information on evacuation using alert levels, so that the citizens can understand the increase in disaster risks intuitively. The alert levels help you link disaster-related information with the actions you should take

disaster-related information with the actions you should take.									
	SCALE	DISASTER RELATED INFORMATION	WHAT TO DO						
	Alert Level 5	When the City recognizes a disaster has already happened in the city, it provides as much the disaster information as possible.	Take utmost measures to save your life.						
	Alert Level 4	The City Office issues an evacuation instruction or an evacuation order.	All family members should <b>start evacuating immediately</b> . If you should think leaving home is more dangerous than staying at home, move to the safest place in your house (e.g. upstairs in case of a flood).						
	Alert Level 3	The City Office issues an <b>evacuation preparation advisory</b> .	The elderly and anyone who needs time to evacuate are required to evacuate. Others should get ready to evacuate at any given time.						
ı	Alert Level 2	The Meteorological Agency issues a <b>heavy rain and/or flood</b> warning.	Check evacuation procedures, using a hazard map.						
	Alert Level 1	The Meteorological Agency issues an early warning.	Stay on alert towards a possible disaster.
