CONSULTATION WITH IMMIGRATION OFFICERS AT CITY OFFICE ON SEPTEMBER 17 HELPS SOLVE YOUR VISA QUESTIONS

Since the implementation of the amended immigration law in April, the new Immigration Services Agency has been reinforcing its outreach programs to work with local governments. Based on the Agency's proprosal, Iruma City has decided to invite two officers to the Information Desk on September 17 (Tuesday) between 9:00 a.m. and noon so that foreign residents in Iruma can ask them questions directly.

You can rest assured that our English speaking advisor is on duty on the day to help you. You can also ask questions by email or fax in English or Japanese, or in other languages (in that case, please send your questions well in advance for translation) by providing necessary information (anonymous if you prefer). Note that these officers cannot give you the final decision about resident permission, but give advice on procedures and necessary documentations.

Anticipated Questions

►"I would like to renew my visa. What kind of documents do I need to get?"

▶ "I would like to invite my mother to take care of my children, and now I am preparing supporting documents. Are these enough? Or do I need other documents?"

FREE PRESCHOOLS AND NURSERY SCHOOLS STARTS IN OCTOBER



With the aim of reducing the financial burden of child-rearing, on

October 1, the new law will be enacted to make preschool education free for all children aged between three and five years of age (as of April 1), with free day care services also to be provided for children up to two years of age from households who are exempted from the resident tax. Parents who are regurally sending their children at present to one of these facilities (including unauthroized nusery schools) will obtain the elibility without application.

The present fee reduction/exemption for househoulds with multiple children will continues for children aged two years and under. **Inquiries**: Hoiku Yochien-ka (Section for Nursery Service and Kindergardens)

For the purpose to ease the impact of the consumption tax hike to 10% which is schedule on October 1, premium vouchers will be sold for (1) citizens who are exempted from the resident tax for the fiscal year 2019 and (2) heads of the households with one or more infants born between April 2, 2016 and September 30, 2019. Vouchers worth $\frac{1}{2}25,000$ will be sold for $\frac{1}{2}0,000$ ($\frac{1}{2}5,000$ premium value), and can be used in the designated stores in Iruma City.

HOW TO GET AND USE THE VOUCHERS

STEP 1: Get an Exchange Ticket

Applications were sent to (1) the citizens who are exempted from resident tax in early August. If you wish to purchase the premium voucher, fill in the form and send it back to Iruma City Office using the enclosed return envelope via postal mail by December 27, 2019. The City will review and send the exchange tickets for purchasing the premium voucher. For (2) heads of the households with infant(s), the City will send the exchange tickets in early September. As for babies born between August 1 and September 30, the tickets will be sent in early October. There is no need to apply for the exchange tickets

STEP 2: Buy Vouchers at City Office

You can buy the vouchers by cash at the counter in the City Office, by showing the exchange ticket and your ID until February 29, 2020. The face value of one voucher is \$5,000 (sold for \$4,000), and you can buy up to five vouchers, either all at a time or individually during the period.



STEP 3: Use Them

One voucher includes ten 500-yen coupons. You can use one or more coupons for shopping at any designated stores in the city, but no change is given. The list of the stores will be sent with the exchange ticket. The vouchers are valid until March 31, 2020.

ANNUAL RENEWAL OF NATIONAL HEALTH INSURANCE CARDS

The current national health insurance (blue) certificate cards will expire at the end of September 2019. New (gray) cards will be sent before the end of September and will be valid from October 1, 2019. Each member of a family will be issued with their own card; however, all cards for the members of the family will be sent to the head of the household in one green envelope by delivery-certified mail. When you receive your new card, detach the card off the main panel. If you do not receive a new certificate by the end of this month, please contact the Kokuho Iryo-ka (Section for Health Insurance and Medical care) as soon as possible. Tips of Living **RENEWAL OF** RESIDENCE CARD

For those who have permanent visa, this may be the time to renew your residence card (zairyu card) for the first time. You must apply for a new card at the immigration office, two months before the expiration date of the residence card that is currently possessed until the said expiration date. Prepare a completed application form and a photograph and your passport and current card. No fee is necessary. The new card will be issued on the same day in principle.
