# ONE-MONTH DEADLINE EXTENSION FOR VISA EXTENSION APPLICATION



With the intention to prevent the spread of COVID-19 infection, the Immigration Service Agency announced the

deadline of visa extension application will be extended for another one month. If your visa expires in April 15, for example, you can apply for extension by May 15. This extension is applicable to visas that expires in March and April only (as of the writing of this article). So those who have visa expiring in May should start application process before the expiration date, just as usual.

#### PENSION PLAN BILLS TO BE MAILED

All residents of Japan who are 20 years of age or over are subject to contributions to the National Pension Plan (kokumin nenkin). The premiums is **16,540 yen per month for the 2020** fiscal year. Participants will receive bills from Japan Pension Service (Nihon Nenkin Kiko) early this month.

Students are exempt from premium payments by request. A request can be made at the City Office and Branch Offices by presenting the student ID card and Pension Handbook (nenkin techo).
