# START PREPARING FOR NURSERY SCHOOL ADMISSION FOR NEXT SPRING

As the new law enacted last year to make pre-school nursery and education free, nursery service has become more affordable, but the admission became more competitive. Although nursery schools (hoikusho or hoikuen) accept applicants all year round, an annual special application period is set early of November for admission for the next school year starting on April. Applicants during this period will be candidates for the primary selection. So if you want to place your chilren in a nusery school, this is the time to get in the action.

**TUITION FREE FOR WHOM?** Pre-school care/education fee is free for all children aged between three and five years old (as of April 1), as well as children up to two years of age from households who are exempted from the resident tax. This is applicable not only to authorized nursery schools but also kindergartens, non-registered (ninkagai) nursery schools and non-regular nusery services. Subsidy of lunch fees is also applicable for low-income households

### WHO CAN USE CITY'S NURSERY SERVICE?

Parents of an infant up to five years old (as of

April 1) can apply for the admission of a nursery school when they (1) work; (2) are pregnant; (3) are sick, injured or disabled; (4) are taking care of a family member who is sick or disabled, etc. Admission will be decided not in order of application, but according to the level of necessity for service.

HOW TO APPLY/WHAT YOU NEED: Each pre-school facility has different service (baby's age/ hours, etc.). So check the list in the application kit available at the City Office, branch offices, nursery schools and from the City Office's website, and apply for a suitable facility. Make an application with necessary documents at any place in the table on the left. The basic documents required are: (1) a set of completed forms (includes application forms, a questionnaire about family situation, a questionnaire about health condition, etc.) and (2) document(s) that support the reason you require the nursery service (such as a certificate of employment or a doctor's certificate etc.).

Note that those who have made an application for 2020 and been waiting for a vacancy is also required for a new application for 2021. Applications for nursery service in May 2021 and after should be submitted on or after March 11, 2021.

#### AFTER-SCHOOL CARE PROGRAM ALSO ACCEPTS APPLICATIONS

The City provides after school nursery rooms (gakudo hoiku) until 6:00 p.m. for school children at all elementary schools in the City. Children whose parents are not at home because of their job or need to take care of a family member can use this service. Application procedures are the same as for nursery services. You can apply at one of the locations in the table, and also at the City Office from November 9 to 16. **Inquiries**: For nursery schools: Hoiku Yochien-ka (Section for Nursery Service and Kindergarten); for after-school care: Seishonen-ka (Section for Youth)

### **HOLIDAY MEDICAL SERVICES**

If you or a family member becomes sick or injured on these days, visit a hospital on the list. Healthcare covered by health insurance is provided from 9:00 a.m. to noon and 1:00 to 5:00 p.m. Please make a call before visiting. These services are basically for patients who do not need to be hospitalized.



### **CHANGE IN VACCINATION INTERVAL**

On and after October 1, 2020, a new vaccination rule is applied for the interval between two different kinds of vaccines (see the table below). There are no changes with the interval of shots for the same kind of vaccines. Also, rotavirus vaccination became "regular" (which means free)



Type of Vaccine	New Rule	Before	
Inactivated vaccines (Hib, pneumococcus, DPT-IPV, etc.)	Can receive another kind of vaccine on the <b>next day</b> of vaccination	Needs 6-day interval before receiving another kind of vaccination	
Live vaccine (Rota, BCG, measles-rubella, chickenpox)	Can receive another kind of vaccine on the <b>next day</b> of vaccination; however, <b>needs at least 27-day interval</b> between live vaccines	Needs 27-day interval before receiving another kind of vaccination

#### **RISE IN THE MINIMUM WAGE TO ¥928**

On October 1, 2020, the minimum wage in Saitama Prefecture will be raised by two yen, it will be now 928 yen per hour. This minimum standard is applicable to all workers and employers in Saitama, regardless of nationality or age. ## EARLY FLU VACCINATION IS RECOMMENED THIS YEAR

The influenza vaccination campaign for the 2020-2021 season will start this month. Because the vaccine takes two weeks to take effect, you are advised to receive one by the middle of December. The City provides a subsidy for the elderly (65 years of age and over), which an elderly can take one for 1,500 yen only. #### MINI SL TRAIN AND AIR-FILLED SHINKANSEN


