RIICHIRO SUGISHIMA ELECTED AS IRUMA' S NEW MAYOR

Iruma will welcome its new young 37-year-old mayor, Riichito Sugishima. The vote election scheduled on October 18 was cancelled, because there was no rival candidate. The current mayor Tatsuo Tanaka had announced his retirement after his two terms of service. The term of the new mayor is from November 18, 2020 to November 17, 2024



Profile of New Mayor Riichiro Sugishima

Born on December 16, 1982. He resides in Toyooka in Iruma. After Azumacho Elementary School and Azumacho Junior High School, he went to Waseda University Senior High School and graduated from Waseda University's Political Science and Economics Department. After working at Japan Finance Corporation, he moved into politics and studied at The Matsushita Institute of Government and Management. He ran for the election of the Saitama Prefectural Assembly and won a seat in 2015. He was serving his second term when resigned to stand in this election. He married his junior high school classmate and has four children.

CITY SUSIDIES FOR FLU VACCINATION IN 2020 SEASON

2,000 YEN SUBSIDY FOR CHILDREN AND PREGNANT WOMEN

Only for this season, Iruma City pays part of the costs for influenza vaccinations for children (6-month-old to the third year of junior high school) and pregnant women who have a resident registration in Iruma City and will receive a vaccination between October 26, 2020 and January 31, 2021. The amount of subsidy is 2,000 yen per person (limited once per person).

After receiving a vaccination, apply using a designated application form (available at the City Office and City Office Branch Offices, and on City's website) with the following papers: (1) Receipt issued by the medical facility (must include your name and date)

(2) A copy of the front page of the Certificate of Medical Subsidy for Children; or copy of the front page of Boshi Techo (for pregnant women)

(3) A copy of your cash card or bankbook of the account to which the subsidy is paid

SEASON OF YEAR END ADJUSTMENT FOR SALARY EARNERS



In accordance with the amendments of income tax rules, the forms for year-end adjustment (nenmatsu chosei) which employees are given by their company will change this year. The major changes include the increase of basic deduction for everybody by 10-man yen (except for high-income earners) and the decrease of salary income deduction by 10-man yen (bigger deduction for those earn more than 850-man yen).

For the adjustment, employees will be given three forms: (1) form for dependent exemption, (2) form for basic/spouse exemptions (image on the left) and (3) form for insurance premium exemption.

These are very much complicated forms. The Information Desk for Foreign Residents is happy to help you complete these forms. Bring the certificates of payments or other relevant documents.

FREE VACCINATION FOR ELDERLY The City provides free vaccination for 65

years of age and over between October 1 and December 31 this year. After January 1, 2021 until January 31, there is 1,500-yen self-pay. After February 1, no subsidy will apply (you pay 100%). To receive a vaccination, make an appointment at a clinic or hospital near you. Bring your health insurance card. Inquires: Chiiki Hoken-ka (Section for Community Health) 204-2966-5511

Because the vaccine takes two weeks to take effect, you are advised to receive one by the middle of December.

VOLCANIC ERUPTIONS AND IRUMA CITY

Out of almost 1,500 active volcanos around the world, 111 are located in Japan. We have no live volcano in Iruma, but damages of ash are expected when Mt. Fuji or Mt. Asama have a major eruption. Volcanic ash is finely crushed volcanic rock, totally different from ash from paper or wood and very hard and prickly.

Volcanic ash causes problems in the respiratory organs, severe ocular pains and inflammation of skin, as well as damages on transportation, agriculutre and sensitive equipment.
