# **BE VIGILANT ABOUT THE RISK OF COVID-19** DURING HOLIDAY SEASON

Faced with the surge of cases, the Government of Japan issued a statement aimed for foreign residents in Japan, who might be looking forward to celebrating the holiday season in their own culture. To prevent the further spread of COVID-19 infection, act prudently and enjoy a safe holiday season.

Avoid participating in events and parties where crowds are likely to occur and basic infection prevention measures are not thoroughly implemented.

When taking part in events and other gatherings, take adequate infection prevention measures by maintaining social distance, sanitizing hands and fingers, wearing masks, and avoiding speaking in loud voices.

## **Chance To Give Your Opinion to The City** SURVEY FOR FOREIGN **RESIDENTS IN IRUMA**

Iruma City Office and Iruma International Friendship Society are planning to conduct a survey next month

to understand better the needs of foreign residents in Iruma. Five hundred (500) randomly chosen foreign residents aged 20 years or over, which means one out of four foreign residents, will receive a big light blue envelope containing a questionnaire and a return envelope. If you get one, please answer questions and send it back to the City Office. Two copies of questionnaires, one in a simple Japanese and the other in English, Chinese, Tagalog, Vietnamese or Spanish (depending on your nationality; the questions are the same) are enclosed. It will not take more than 15 minutes to answer. Information you give will never be used for other purposes and kept confidential. We thank you for your co-operation for helping us serve you better. ### NEW TENANT INVITED FOR MUNICIPAL HOUSING UNITS



New tenant for vacancies of municipal apartments are invited this month. Application forms are available until December 21 (Mon) at the Toshi

Keikaku-ka (Section for City Planning), City Branch Offices (Higashi-Kaneko, Kaneko, Miyadera, Fujisawa and Seibu) and Satellite Offices (Kurosu and Higashi-Fujisawa). Apply by December 21 by mail (must be postmarked by the date). The application process is handled by the Prefectural Housing Cooperation (jutaku Kyokyu Kosha). Just like prefectural apartments, candidates are selected by lottery and then their eligibility is reviewed with various documents such as income certificates.
