NEW YEAR'S GREETING FROM THE NEW MAYOR

I wish everyone happiness and prosperity in the New Year!

Last year, the coronavirus pandemic seriously affected our social and economic life. I imagine that everyone had an uneasy year. I would like to pay my heartfelt respects and gratitude especially to healthcare

professionals and other essential workers who have been making efforts to sustain our daily life.

On the first New Year's Day after my inauguration last November, I renewed my resolution to make Iruma a place "good to come, good to live and good to work." As the youngest mayor in Saitama Prefecture, I am going to try measures that have no precedent while valuing history and traditional culture, to aim for an administration of "Stability and Challenge."

WHEN YOU HAVE SYMPTOMS VISIT DESIGNATED FEVER CLINICS WITH PRIOR APPOINTMENT

IT'S ABOUT TIME TO PREPARE YOUR 2020 FINAL TAX RETURNS

It's time for you to start preparing for your final tax return for those who are

self-employed, employees who have missed year-end adjustment (年末調整'nenmatsu chosei') for some reasons (probably because you work part-time, your company does not take care of your tax payment, or you guit your job in the middle of the year), or you may want to apply through the process for exemptions which your

company cannot handle (such Feb 2 Kurosu Kominkan as housing loan exemption and dependent overseas exemption).

Final tax return for 2020 must be filed by March 15 (Mon). The Information Desk is happy to help you with your processing. Just bring all the related documents, including the gensen choshu hyo, a certificate of life insurance premium payment, receipts of medical expense, etc. Also you can submit your completed tax
