Free COVID-19 Testing has started in Saitama Prefecture, and you can check whether you are infected or not for free of charge.

Who can take a test?: Residents of Saitama Prefecture who have NO symptoms such as fever, and have a fear being infected.

Where in Iruma?: Available at a clinical lab and several drug stores.

THIRD DOSE OF COVID-19 VACCINE IN PROGRESS IN IRUMA

In the midst of rapid spread of Omicron variant, City of Iruma is trying to offer booster doses for citizens as early as possible. Coupons will be sent in series based on the vaccine supply situation. As before, after having received the coupon, you can make an appointment through the city's special site or call center at one of scheduled medical facilities. You cannot make one directly at facilities.

Cross-vaccination: For the third dose, the Japanese government has approved cross-vaccination with a different vaccine from the one used in the first two doses. The City of Iruma used Pfizer vaccine only for first and second doses, but it is expected that we will be supplied with more Moderna from now on. So, please consider cross-vaccination to get the earliest possible opportunity of vaccination.

Making Appointment: Once you receive a coupon for the third dose, make an appointment (1) by calling Iruma's call center ☎0570-012894 or (2) through a special web site: https://vaccines.sciseed.jp/irumacovid19/login (guide available in several foreign languages through the menu icon on the right top).

Vaccination for 5 to 11 years old: The City is now preparing so that we can start in accordance with the national campaign.

Tax returns for the year

2021 should be filed by March 15 (Tue). You can do the filing procedure at the several locations on the table, and at the City Office from Monday to Friday from February 22 to March 15, and on Sunday, February 27. Bring your Gensen Choshu-Hyo, and other supporting documents such as documents relating dependents, a certificate of

If you have gone through the year-end adjustment (nenmatsu chosei) procedures by your company, you do not have to worry about the final tax return, except when you have any deductible expenses not reported to the company such as a large amount of medical expenses and housing loan.

NOTICE OF ACCEPTANCE FOR NEW SCHOOL CHILDREN

A "notice of acceptance" should have been mailed to all parents of children who will commence elementary school and junior high school next spring (those who were born between April 2, 2015 and April 1, 2016, and those who were born between April 2, 2009 and April 1, 2010, respectively) by the end of January. If you have not received a notice yet, or if your child will not attend the designated school, please contact the Gakko Kyoiku-ka in the City Office (4th floor).

Parents of applicable children need to attend a parent meeting at the school their children will attend, in late January or early February. These meetings are essential for understanding school life in Japan and include the purchasing of school supplies. The meeting schedule is different for each school.

MAKE YOUR 'MY' NUMBER CARD Special Gift Campaign

City is now offering a special gift for those who make a MY number card. You can choose a bag of Sayama tea, sweets using tea leaves, or products of Sado Island. This campaign will end as soon as the gift stock has run out. Applications for the card can be made, including taking a picture to attach, at the City Office or Branch Offices. Also, from this month to March 31, 2023, Iruma City will issue various certificates for only 10 yen, if you have your 'MY' number card. Certificates include juminhyo (certificate of resident registration) and kazei/nozei shomeisho (certificates of tax amount/tax payment), and even koseki tohon (certificate of permanent family register; only for koseki in Iruma). 

NATIONAL HEALTH INSURANCE PREMIUM REVISED FOR FY 2022

The aging population and growing medical expenses have been pressuring the financial status of the National Health Insurance Scheme in Iruma City. Although the City has kept the premium rate unchanged for years, but now it is unavoidable to revise the premium rate because we expect transfer from Iruma's financial adjustment fund cannot make up the revenue shortfall enough in the fiscal year of 2022.

The City started applying the new premium rates in April 2022. The premium on per capita basis (computed evenly according to the number of family members) will be increased from 40,000 yen to 43,000 yen a year (total of medical benefit/kaigo/support for elderly), along with some increase of the income-based premium.

The City will strengthen its efforts to reduce medical expenses (e.g. promotion of generic drugs and health promoting programs) and increase income (e.g. collection of unpaid premiums).
