COVID-19 VACCINATION COUPONS FOR 3RD SHOT TO 12 to 17 YEARS OLD

Last April 14, the City of Iruma started to send coupons for third (booster) shots of COVID-19 vaccination for 12 to 17 years old citizens for whom six months have passed since their second shot. The same Pfizer vaccines as adults were used. Those who have received the coupon can make appointments on the "Third Shot Appointment" page of the Iruma City website, or at the Call Center.

Appointments for 1st/2nd Shots and 3rd Shots for Adults Are Also Available There are currently three vaccination appointment webpages:

(1) **First/Second Shot Appointments**: For those who are twelve years old and older. Available at eight clinics in the City. Appointments for the second shot are automatically made. (2) **Third Shot Appointments**: For those who are twelve years old and older. Available at thirty-one clinics in the City. Each clinic has a different age range. Some hospitals use Moderna vaccine. <u>http://www.city.iruma.saitama.jp/shisei/bousai/1010191/1012463/1013666.html</u>

(3) **Appointments for 5 to 11-yr-old Children**: Available at seven clinics in the City. Only Pfizer vaccine for children is used.

NATIONAL HEALTH INSURANCE TAX DEDUCTION FOR PRESCHOOL CHILDREN

From the 2022 fiscal year and after, Iruma City applies a deduction of National Health Insurance (NHI) tax (i.e. premium) for households who have preschool NHI-enrolled child(ren). The per-capita portion of their child(ren) is halved. When the deduction in per-capita is already applied according to the household income, the deducted per-capita portion is further halved. **Inquiries;** Kokuho Iryo-ka (Section for NHI and Medical Service)

DOG & CAT MICROCHIP IMPLANTATION & REGISTRATION TO BE MANDATED

In Japan, on June 1, 2022 and on, all dogs and cats sold by bleeders and shops are required to be implanted with a microchip. When you purchase a dog or cat, you must register the ID number of the microchip at the registry operated by the Ministry of Environment through online or by postal mail. For owners of dogs and cats, it is also

strongly encouraged to make their pet implanted with a chip. **Free registration is now being offered until May 31, 2022**, for those who have already made a registration at one of five designated organizations and seek for transfer of the registration. Visit <u>https://www.aipo.jp/transfer</u>. After the period, a fee of 300 yen will be charged.

RECONSTRUCTION OF CITY OFFICE BUILDING IN PROGRESS



The City is planning to rebuild the so-called A and B buildings. The new C building will be kept and to be used, and new two buildings, one for office and one for citizen's activities, will be built within the premises. In the 2022 fiscal year, a project contract will be signed with a selected company, and after designing, actual construction will start in the 2024 fiscal year. The new office building is planned to be completed in the 2025 fiscal year.

The main policies for the new buildings are:

Second floors; Increased convenience for visitors with one-stop services; Enhanced functions as disaster relief headquarters;
