RULE CHANGES IN CHILD ALLOWANCE NO NEED TO SUBMIT AN ANNUAL UPDATE ANY MORE

The government of Japan amended the law to discontinue the annual update which the beneficiaries of child allowance (児童手当 *Jido Teate*) were required to submit in June every year. Households bringing up children up to the end of junior high school now can continue to receive the allowance automatically, as a general rule. Only when the city cannot confirm the eligibility based on the public records, the city will send a form for confirmation to the household.

INCOME LIMIT FOR ELIGIBILITY TO BE APPLIED

Also, in accordance with the amendment of the law, from the payment in October 2022 and so on, households whose main breadwinner earns more than about 12 million yen a year will be excluded from child allowance eligibility.

MONTHS OF PAYMENT

Child allowances are paid three times a year, in June, October, and February for the period until the end of the previous month.

FOURTH DOSE OF COVID-19 VACCINE FOR SELECTED CITIZENS

City of Iruma is preparing to offer fourth doses for applicable citizens. Coupons will be sent to (1) those over 60 who have gone five months since their third dose, and (2) those over 18 and under 60 who have some underlying disease. As before, after

having received the coupon, you can make an appointment through the city's special website for fourth doses or at call center \$\infty\$0570-012894. You cannot make your appointment

directly at medical facilities. Vaccines manufactured by Pfizer or Moderna will be used.

Although they cannot give final decisions, they can give helpful suggestion and opinions. The three advisors from the Information Desk for Foreign Residents who can speak English, Spanish and Chinese will be present during these hours, you can consult in the languages mentioned. You can also ask questions by email or fax in your language (please send your questions well in advance for translation) by providing necessary information (anonymous if you prefer).

PREVIOUSLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Q: The definition of the age of majority was lowered to 18. Does this have any influence on my status of long-term resident as a dependent of permanent resident?

A: The change of legal adult age should not serve as a sufficient condition for cancelling of your long-term status.

Q: I am a permanent resident, and gave birth to a child in my country. Can the baby enter Japan as a child of permanent resident?

A: A child of permanent resident status is appliable only to children who were born in Japan. In this case, you should seek for a long-term status for the baby, just like summoning a child.

FREE HEALTH EXAMINATION FOR NATIONAL HEALTH INSURANCE MEMBERS

In late May, the Iruma City Office sent a free medical check-up voucher (受診券 jushin ken) to all National Health Insurance members and Later-Stage Elderly Insurance members. The voucher can be used at a medical clinic or hospital in the City between June 2022 and February 2023. The check-up will focus mainly on the prevention of lifestyle-related diseases and will include blood tests, urine test and an electrocardiogram. To take these checkups, make an appointment at a hospital/clinic beforehand, and bring a completed interview sheet (the voucher) and your health insurance card with you. For those who are covered by a company's health insurance, a similar opportunity for health checkup will be given by the company.
