EMERGENCY RELIEF BENEFITS OF ¥50,000 FOR HOUSEHOLDS WHOSE RESIDENT TAXES ARE EXEMPTED OR WHOSE INCOME DECREASED

The Government of Japan provides a special benefit (50,000 yen per household) to households having financial difficulty, as a means to support them cope with rising prices. When all the member of your household are exempted from per capita basis of resident tax for the fiscal year 2022 (which is based on the income in 2021) as of September 30, 2022, your household should have **automatically received a confirmation form** for this benefit last month.

The form you received has already contain your information, i.e. name, address, as well as bank account to receive the benefits, so you just check the box on the form to confirm the information and send it back to the city office using the enclosed envelope.



Also, households whose income has dra _____matically decreased may receive this benefit by applying. Your

BENEFITS FOR EXPECTING MOTHERS & Mothers of Newborn Babies

The City offers a special one-time **benefit of 30,000 yen** to mothers-to-be and mothers of newborn babies so that they can spend a peaceful time with their baby. You are eligible if you are an Iruma citizen and:

(1) Received/will receive your boshi-techo (mother & child book) between October 1, 2022 and December 31, 2022; or

(2) Received your boshi-techo after January 1, 2020, and has your resident registration at Iruma as of October 1, 2022. Those who fall in (1) will be given an application form at the time they receive their boshi-techo. Those who fall in (2) should have received an application form late October. Apply by mail **by January 31, 2023.**

If you have child(ren) under 18 and your household income decreased by the impact of COVID-19 pandemic, you may receive this once-only benefit of 50,000 yen per child by applying with proof documents.
