RECONSTRUCTION PROJECT OF CITY HALL BUILDINGS STARTED

To replace its A and B buildings that do not meet the current earthquakeresistance standards, Iruma City closed a contract last month for the design and construction of the new building. After the basic and execution designs starting in 2023 fiscal year, the actual construction will start in 2024 fiscal year, and the new building will be completed by the end of March 2026. CITY COMMENCED FY 2023 BUDGET Even More Strategic Budget Allocation



Based on the aproval by the city assembly in March, Iruma City has commenced implementing its budget for the 2023 fiscal year. Expecting a gradual recovery trend of economy, the City's budget for the general account for FY 2023 will be 48,010

million ven, increase by 3,000 million ven year-on-year. The budget focus on promoting industry by preparing industry sites, facilitating public service through DX, and enhancing the efforts for 2050 carbon neutrality. The budget also includes the restration and repairing of the former Kurosu Bank building and the designing of the new city hall building. On the other hand, the last year's plan for the development of a new landfill site has been aborted with the efforts of reducing the total volume of incineration ash.
