

TO PLACE YOUR CHILDREN IN A NURSERY SCHOOL **DO NOT MISS APPLICATION PERIOD STARTING OCT 31**



As for nursery schools (hoikusho or hoikuen) in Iruma, an annual special application period is set during the first week of November for admission for the next school year starting on April 1. Admissions are decided in this selection process based on the levels of necessity for nursery service. Although you can apply for the service all year around, you will be admitted only when there's a vacant spot in a specific school. So, if you want to place your children in a nursery

school, this is the time to get in the action.

HOW TO APPLY: Each pre-school facility has different service (baby's age/ hours, etc.). So check the list in the application kit available at the City Office, branch offices, nursery schools and from the City Office's website, and apply for a suitable facility. Applications can be made with necessary documents at the Kyoiku Center (third floor of the Library building in the Sangyo

Bunka Center on October 31 (Tue) and November 1 (Wed) and at the Kenko Fukushi (Health & Welfare) Center between Novemenber 2 (Thu) and 6 (Mon). However, to avoid overcrowding, you need to make an appointment beforehand through the City's official LINE account on and after October 10 (Tue) 9:00 a.m. (use the 2D barcode right). PAPERS YOU NEED TO APPLY: The basic documents required for application are: (1) a set of completed forms (includes an

application form, a questionnaire about family situation, a questionnaire about health condition, etc.) and (2) document(s) that support the reason you require the nursery service (such as a certificate of employment or a doctor's certificate etc.). The City provides after school nursery rooms (gakudo hoiku) until 6:00 p.m. for school children at all elementary schools in the City. Children whose parents are not at home because of their job or need to take care of a family member can use this service. Application procedures are the same as for nursery services. You can apply at the same place and date as above as well as between November 7 to 10 (Tue to Fri) and on 13 (Mon) at the City Hall. Inquiries: Seishonen-ka (Section for Youth)

Iruma City Office will sell premium evouchers, called "e-Smile Ticket," which can be used in the designated stores in the city until January 31, 2024. The electronic vouchers worth 7,000 yen will be sold for

5,000 yen: numbers are limited to 40,000. Iruma citizens can apply to purchase the vouchers through the designated website until October 13 (Fri).
