IRUMA IS SERIOUS ABOUT SUPPORT FOR YOUNG CARER

First Anniversary of the Establishment of the Ordinance

Young careers (or caregivers) are now becoming a growing social problem in Japan. Who are young carers? You are the one if you're under 18 and do extra jobs in and around the home regularly such as:

- Looking after a younger brother or sister,
- Giving a lot of physical help to a family member who's disabled or ill,
- Giving your family member emotional support,
- Doing the chores such as cooking or cleaning on regular basis, and
- Functioning as interpreter for parents who do not speak Japanese.

Unlike children who just help their parents around the house, young carers cannot decide how much and what type of care they give. Quite often they spend a lot of time in their duties, and they cannot do well at school and do the same kinds of things as other children. Some young carers fall into ill health from overwork and stress.

It has been a year since Iruma City established the nation's first Ordinance for Supporting Young Carers, which provides that the City, their school, and people around them should offer supports to help young carers. There have already been a number of programs available to support them, including learning support, housekeeping support, food aids, and much more. DON'T GIVE UP EDUCATION! CITY'S INTEREST-FREE EDUCATION LOANS

Is your child planning to go to high school in the coming spring, but you have financial difficulties? Iruma City offers an interest free education loan to be repaid within seven years after graduation, which is applicable for both high school and college students. For example, a new high school student on the loan program would receive 100,000 yen upon entrance and 10,000 yen every month during the course of their study. Income limits apply. Necessary documents include a recommendation letter by the principal of the current school, a proof of income, a letter of co-signer, etc. Application forms will be distributed between December 5 (Tue) and January 10 (Wed), and accepted on weekdays between **December 22 (Fri) and January 15 (Mon)** at the Gakko Kyoiku-ka in the City Office. **Inquiries**: Gakko Kyoiku-ka (Section for School Education)

CITY SUBSIDIZES PURCHASE OF BIKE HELMETS

All the people should endeavor to wear a helmet when riding a bicycle in Japan. The motality rate of riders with a helmet is less than half of those without a helmet.

Iruma City has started a subsidy for purchasing bike helmets that meet the standard (with one of the marks below). The amount of subsidy is a half of the price of the helmet or up to 2,000 yen. The



applicant must be the purchaser, and the user of the helmet must be under 18 or over 65 who have bicycle insurance. Apply with the proof of purchase, the proof of insurance and the applicant's ID, at the Kotsu Bohan-ka or on City's official LINE account.
