ELIGIBILITY FOR CHILD ALLOWANCES TO BE EXTENDED

NEW ELIGIBLE HOUSEHOLDS NOTICED THIS MONTH

To address the decreasing birth rate in the county, the Japanese government decided to extend the eligibility for child allowance (jido teate) on October 1, 2024. Households who become eligible because of this extension will receive a notice late this month. You may be asked to register a bank account to receive this allowance. Major points of changes include:

>Elimination of income restrictions: Child allowances will be provided regardless of the income of the main livelihood maintainer.

>Extension of eligible children: Until the end of September, the allowance is for children up to 15 years old. Now the allowance will cover all the children from 0 to high school age (until the first March 31 after reaching the age of 18).

➤Increase in the amount of payment for third and subsequent children: They will receive 30,000 yen a month up to 18. Also, they will be regarded as 'third' until their eldest sibling becomes 22 years old.

>Changes in payment to six times a year: Two months' payments will be made in February, April, June, August, October, December. Inquiries: Kodomo Shien-ka (Section for Child Welfare)

TARGETED BENEFITS TO EASE UTILITY COST SURGE

In accordance with the national policy, the city offers a **special once- only benefit of 100,000 yen** per household for those who are exempted from resident taxes for 2024. When the household has child(ren) under 18, additionally 50,000 yen per child will be provided. All eligible households should have received a notice from the city. SUBSIDIES FOR TAX DEDUCTION ADJUSTMENT

In June, the government implemented income and resident tax deductions by fixed amounts, 30,000 yen and 10,000 yen respectively, for all the taxpayers. But for those whose tax amounts are less than these amounts, the city is going to pay the same amount as subsidies in coming months. Eligible citizens should have already received a notice. IN-PERSON REPORT FOR RENEWAL OF SINGLE PARENT ALLOWANCE

The City provides a child-rearing allowance (児童扶養手当 Jido Fuyo Teate) to single-parent households bringing up children up to the end of junior high school. You must renew your registration every year. Early this month, the City Office will send forms to those who are already receiving child allowance (現沢届 Genkyo-todoke), and the recipient parent him/herself needs to complete the form and submit in person during the designated period of time in August.

TAKE CAREFUL PRECAUTIONS AGAINST HEAT STROKE!

Last month, more than 1,600 people in Saitama used ambulances due to heat stroke. Iruma has inland weather which can be very hot in summer. Learn about heat stroke and prevent it wisely.

Because of environmental conditions such as high temperature, high humidity and a lack of wind, or because of heat production from exercise or labor, the body loses control of body temperature, causing



heat accumulation and affecting organ function. Dizziness, cramps, numbness and abnormal sweating are typical symptoms of early heat stroke. If you see these symptoms, move to a cool place, and take plenty of water and minerals.

To prevent heat stroke, regularly take fluids and stay cool inside with fans and air conditioning. When a heatstroke alert is issued for Saitama Prefecture, the City of Iruma will **open its 25 public facilities as "cooling shelters"** where people can stay within the airconditioned rooms.
