BICYCLE REGULATIONS TIGHTENED FROM NOVEMBER 1

From November 1, 2024, the Amended Road Traffic Act will be implemented. Using a smartphone while riding and riding under the influence of alcohol are regarded as a violation of the law and would be subject to harsher imprisonment or fines. This is because of the recent increase in accidents caused by careless riders. Follow traffic rules when riding a bicycle.

Using a smartphone while riding a bicycle: ¥100,000 fine?!

Holding a phone or watching a screen while riding a bicycle is subject to imprisonment for not more than six months



or a fine of not more than 100,000 yen. It is not illegal to check your phone while waiting at traffic lights, but you must be careful because you are still on the road.

Holding an umbrella while riding a bicycle is also subject to up to 50,000 yen fine. In short, you need to hold the handle with both hands all the time.

Riding a bicycle under the influence of alcohol: ¥500,000 fine?!

If the rider's breath alcohol content is over 0.15 mg per litter, imprisonment for not more than three years or a fine of not more than 500,000 yen would be imposed.

Bicycle insurance and helmets:

Saitama Prefecture has made bicycle insurance legally mandatory. You need to purchase bicycle liability insurance, which can be arranged on the internet and costs a couple hundred yen a month.

Also, the law obliges bicycle riders to make efforts to wear a helmet. There is no penalty, but wear a helmet for your own safety.

Other Rules for Bicycles:

Ride a bicycle on a roadway on the left-hand side. Riding on a sidewalk is allowed only in exceptional circumstances. Use a light: riding without a light at night is very dangerous.

In Japan, the issuance of health insurance cards will be discontinued on December 2, 2024 and MY number cards will be the main insurance certificate. However, your current health insurance card is valid until the expiration date printed on the card. If you have

not registered your MY number card as your health insurance card by the expiration date, your insurance organization will automatically send you a certificate of confirmed membership (資格確認書 shikaku kakunin-sho). Opens on November 23 (Saturday)



CITY FINANCIAL RESULTS FOR FY 2023 PUBLISHED

Iruma City has closed its books for the 2023 fiscal year which ended on March 31, 2024. In the general account, the overall revenue came in at 49,317 million yen, which is a 1.2% increase from the previous year. The expenditure also increased by 2.2% to 48,099 million yen.

¥150,846 vs. ¥333,412 per capita

Municipal taxes contributed 21,761 million yen (44.13% of the total revenue) which equates to 150,846 yen per capita, while the expenditure per capita was about 333,412 yen. The difference is mostly covered by the subsidies from the National governments and loans.

We are in a healthy financial state

There are several barometers for the health of municipal finance. For Iruma, we have good results in all, including the ratio of the budget deficit, the ratio of the burden for the future and the funding gap for public-service companies. **Inquiries:** Zaisei-ka (Financial Section)
