## WE ARE ALWAYS CHILD-CENTERED! IRUMA CITY CHILDREN PLAN FORMULATED

The national government has adopted the slogan "Children at the Center" to place support for children and families raising children at the center of its policies. Iruma City has also formulated the "Iruma City Children Plan," which targets all children and child-rearing families (including pregnant and postpartum women), to promote the creation of a "child-centered" town. This comprehensive plan includes various actions, such as policies for the entire society to support children and child-rearing families, support for healthy development of children and young people, measures against child poverty, support for single-parent families to become independent, support for maternal and child health, and measures tailored to children's developmental stages and difficult situations.

### **Background of the Plan:**

Rapid decline in the birth rate: Due to late marriage and childbirth, women's social advancement, and diversifying values, the rate of birth decline is accelerating nationwide. In Iruma City, the total fertility rate is also guite low at 0.95 in 2023 (1.20 for the whole country).

Changing situation around children and child-rearing families: More than ever, it is necessary to address issues such as the anxiety and burden of raising children, long waiting lists for admission to nursery schools, child poverty, etc. It is also necessary for society as a whole to support children so that they can grow up healthy and live social lives in their own way, while recognizing that children are subjects of rights.

### **Examples of Initiatives** Supports for young carers:

"Young carers" are children under 18 who do extra jobs in



and around the home regularly. Iruma City enacted Young Carer Support Ordinance and dispatches a householder helper or a tutor to families in need to relieve the burden of young carers.

Creating places for children: In the City, there are many people and organizations that run children's cafeterias or provide learning support. The city will cooperate with these activities to create places and playgrounds by providing places such as community centers.

Children & Family Centers: Provide comprehensive supports from pregnancy all through the period of child rearing.

Come to the Information Desk (2<sup>nd</sup> floor of the City Hall) during these hours and consult via video call. The three advisors from the Information Desk for Foreign Residents who can speak English, Spanish and Chinese will be present with you, so you can consult in the languages

mentioned. Appointments at least one day in advance are advisable. You can also ask questions by email or fax in your language (please send your questions well in advance for translation) by providing necessary information (anonymously if you prefer). New tenants for vacancies of unexpensive municipal apartments are invited this month. Application forms are available until June 20 (Fri) at the Toshi Keikaku-ka (Section for City Planning)

and Chiku Centers. Apply by June 20 by postal mail (must be postmarked by the date). The application process is handled by the Prefectural Housing Cooperation (Jutaku Kyokyu Kosha). Just like prefectural apartments, candidates are selected by lottery and then their eligibility is reviewed with various documents such as income certificates. There are income limits applicable.

## WATER PIPE LEAK INSPECTIONS TO BE CONDUCTED In Toyooka and Kaneko Districts in FY2025

The City regularly conducts leak inspections of the water supply pipes. This inspection uses a sound-listening rod to check for the presence or absence of leaking sounds from the water supply pipes buried under the roads to the water meters on private premises. Pipes up to the water meters are under the management of the city.

An inspector commissioned by the city with a city-issued identification card and an armband will visit your home to check for leaks. Even if you are not at home, they may enter the premises and inspect the water meter to check for leaking sounds. They will never enter the building. There is no charge at all.
