COOPERATE FOR THE POPULATION CENSUS 由本 2025 the most important statistical survey

The National Government will conduct a population census as of October 1, 2025. This once-every-five - years census aims to understand the actual conditions of all the people living in Japan, including non-Japanese people, and their households and to obtain basic data for various administrative measures and other programs. The results will be used only for statistical purposes and the information you provide will never be used for any purpose related to immigration control, taxation, or police activities.

HOW TO ANSWER THE QUESTIONS

RECEIVE A FORM FROM A CENSUS COLLECTOR

Late this month, a census collector will visit your home and give you a form and a guidebook. This guidebook is available in 27 languages. So specify your language to the census collector.

SEND ANSWERS ONLINE OR BY POSTAL MAIL

You need to answer the questions by October 8 (Wed) either by accessing the online site or by filling out and sending the census form by postal mail. By using the QR code on the form which includes login information, you can immediately start answering questions. It will take less than ten minutes.

CENSUS COLLECTOR WILL COME IF YOU FAIL TO ANSWER

In case you have not responded either online or by sending the form by October 8, a census collector will visit you again between October 17 and 27 to collect the filled-out form.

FAQs

- I live in a different address from the one on my residence card.

 For the census, fill out the form at the place where you normally (i.e. for more than three months) live as of October 1st, regardless of the address on your residence card.
- My child has returned to our home country temporarilly. Should I include him in the census?
 - When he/she has been in his country for more than 3 months as of October 8, do not include him/her.
- There are multiple households living in one house (e.g. my parents' household and my own household). Should we answer separately?
 If a building has two entrances, two kitchens, etc., please answer separately. Also, if households have completely separate incomes, answer separately. If you live together and have the shared income, answer as one household.

You need to download the application, but it is highly recommended.
